Yep, it was a hot summer and it was tough on some lawns. If your grass isn't looking its best, there is still time to fix it. Fall is a great time for core aeration and overseeding. Pre-emergent crabgrass applications make spring overseeding difficult because the pre-crab stops grass seed germination. Aeration is helpful for improving any turf and promotes root expansion. Sowing grass seed will thicken the thin patches. Ask Tim or Dave for a check up!
